Analyte description	CYFRA 21-1 is a fragment of cytokeratin 19 which is expressed in various types of epithelial cells and tumor cells of epithelial origin. Serum CYFRA 21-1 has been used as a tumor marker of different origins and especially in non-small cell lung cancer.

Stability testing is performed in the product buffer to see whether different temperatures affect the antigen binding, charge or composition of the antibody. Please note that the shelf life given on the first page is based on real time stability testing at 2–8 °C in the product buffer.
