Analyte description PIGF is a member of the vascular endothelial growth factor (VEGF) family.

Its molecular structure is a glycoprotein homodimer, and it has four

isoforms. PIGF stimulates endothelial cell proliferation and migration, and it binds to the receptor FLT1/VEGFR-1. PIGF is typically measured in combination with sFIt-1 to determine the sFIt-1/PIGF ratio. The sFIt-1/PIGF ratio is intended for use as an aid in the diagnosis of preeclampsia, in

conjunction with other diagnostic and clinical information.
